A whoopie pie (alternatively called a gob, black-and-white, bob, or "BFO" for (Big Fat Oreo) is a baked good made of two round mound-shaped pieces of cake, the most common flavor being chocolate, with a sweet, creamy frosting sandwiched between them.

According to food historians, industrious Amish women would bake these delicious desserts with leftover cake batter and icing and would put them in farmers' lunchboxes. When farmers would find these treats in their lunch, they would shout "Whoopie!"

The recipe for whoopie pies has its origins with the Amish, and in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, it is not uncommon to find roadside farm stands offering these desserts.


